### Awards Ceremony

Awards will be presented at a breakfast ceremony to be held at in Downtown Providence, at 8:00am on Thursday, May 6, 2009.

### Entry Guidelines

Entries must:

- Have been published or on the air in 2009.
- Increase public interest in or knowledge of diversity.
- Inform the public in new or engaging ways.
- Be well conceived or produced whether in print, radio, television or electronic web/internet format.

Entries are limited to one (1) per author. Submit three (3) copies of each entry.

Provide written copies if in print or on web. Provide DVD for filmed entries. (Transcripts are not needed for filmed entries). Foreign language submissions, please include English translation.

All entries remain the property of the organization or individual. No entries will be returned.

### Categories

Awards are given for Print, Broadcast (Radio and Television) and Web/Internet media. A final category recognizes a unique or unusually outstanding effort in any media.

### Judging

Entries are judged by a local, independent panel convened by RICJ.
